1. General Information

Acro Clube da Maia and the Maia City Hall, with the support of the Portuguese Federation of Trampoline and Sports Acrobatics, are pleased to organize the

3rd Maia International Acro Cup

This Tournament will take place in the city of Maia between the 4th and the 8th of March 2009 – as always, in the first complete week of March.

The **Maia International Acro Cup** is opened for National / Regional Teams, as well for Club Teams.

There will be also a Team Competition for Age Groups, Juniors and Seniors. The Team classification is defined by the sum of the marks of 4 pairs or groups (no matter if they are repeated; example: 4 Mix Pairs or 2 Men Four and 2 Women Trio).

This competition is being prepared in accordance with the FIG regulations and rules and subsequent decisions of the FIG Executive Committee and Sports Acrobatics Commission.

There will be two parallel competitions (and therefore two different final classifications). One according to the **FIG Age Rules** and another with the following age groups:

AGE GROUP: minimum 9 years old – maximum 16 years old (with a maximal difference of 6 years between partners)

JUNIORS: minimum 11 years old – maximum 19 years old (with a maximal difference of 7 years between partners)

SENIORS: minimum 13 years old

4. Maximum Delegation Size

Each delegation may include:

- 1 Head of delegation
- 1 Team Manager
- 4 Coaches
- 1 Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- At least 1 judge is obligatory – **180€ penalty fee**
- Unlimited acrobatic pairs / groups

5. Competition Programme

Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories

Qualifications: 1 Balance and 1 Tempo exercise

Finals: top six or top eight or top twelve of qualifications, depending on the amount of pairs/groups per category (1 to 8 – 6 finalists; 9 to 16 – 8 finalists; more than 16 – 12 finalists)

Juniors and Seniors – Final – Combined

Age Group – Choice between Balance or Tempo exercise

6. Technical Rules

All the following FIG rules considered as valid in 2009:

- New Code of Points (2009 – 2012)
- SAWAGG Rules (latest version)
- FIG Apparatus Norms

7. Drawing of Lots

The drawing for the starting order will be made in advance, under the control of the Competition Manager and Organizer Committee members.

It will take place on the 24th February 2009.

The Draw will be videotaped and put on the web (official web site).

9. Deadlines for Entries and Finance Obligations

Definitive entry: by 19th January 2009 (**30% ACCOMODATION + ENTRY FEE**)

Nominative entry: by 23rd February 2009 (NO PAYMENTS)

The Head of Delegation will receive meal tickets upon arrival at accreditation.

Transfers by bus to and from the **Porto airport** to the official hotel, as well as from the official hotel to the training and competition hall, will be provided to delegations who booked their accommodation through the Organizing Committee.

12. Visa

If you need an official invitation to obtain a visa to travel to Portugal, please contact the OC as soon as possible.

13. Insurance

All delegations are responsible for ensuring the appropriate coverage against accidents and illness. The OC will verify the certificates of insurance of all delegation members upon arrival at accreditation. All accredited persons who cannot provide proof of adequate insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete.

14. Medical Services

The Organizing Committee will provide medical services. A physiotherapist and Red Cross personnel will be present during competitions. A physiotherapist will be present during all training sessions.

15. Media & Media Conferences

Media representatives (journalists, photographers, TV) must request a special accreditation from the OC. Please contact the OC as soon as possible. The media will be assigned special seating and working conditions.

16. Accreditation

The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the competition and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants

and officials are required to wear accreditation cards at all times.

At accreditation, the Head of Delegation must check the correct names of their complete delegation, verify accommodation requirements, make the necessary payments (including insurance, if necessary) and hand in the music CDs of the competitors. They also have to present the passports of all competitors and judges for control of nationality and age. The definitive competition schedule will be given to the Head of Delegation.

The accreditation is personal, non-transferable and compulsory to control access to training and competition hall, functions, official transport, lunches and dinners.

Without your accreditation card, you cannot pass the security control and you cannot participate in lunches, dinners, etc. So, if you loose your accreditation card, you will have to buy a new one for the price of 125 Euro.

Additional accreditations can be requested. The price of 125 Euro per extra accreditation includes free entry to competition, training and Farewell Party.

The **pictorial declarations** must be in our possession until the 27th of February 2009.

17. Orientation Meeting

The orientation meeting will take place on Thursday 5th of March on the City Hall. This meeting is for Head of Delegation, Team managers, Judges and Coaches. Each head of delegation will receive the official competition plan.

18. Opening Ceremony

All competitors will be requested to participate in the Opening Ceremony on Saturday, 7th March. The National or Team tracksuit must be worn.

19. Medal Award Ceremonies

All finalists are requested to participate in Medal Award Ceremonies. They are requested to appear in competition suit. **Top 3** will receive medals and the rest of the finalists will receive participation diplomas.

There will be a Team Competition (Age Group, Junior and Senior).

There will be a **PRIZE MONEY** for the **Senior Competition** as following:

1st place – 150 USD (for each partner of the Pair/Group)

2nd place – 100 USD (for each partner of the Pair/Group)

3rd place – 70 USD (for each partner of the Pair/Group)

A **Special Prize Money Award** will be given to the best Balance and Tempo routines (sum of the Balance and Tempo overall marks): 200 USD (for the Pair/Group).

Also a **Special Prize Money Award** will be given to the higher difficulty in Competition: 200 USD (for the Pair/Group).

20. Farewell Party

A farewell party will be organized and will be followed by disco and dance.

All delegations that have booked their accommodation with the OC are invited to participate without additional payment.

Extra tickets will be available at the OC office at 25 Euro per person. Requests for extra tickets must be made, at the very latest, by Sunday morning (8th of March).

21. Additional Information

All further information concerning the detailed program will be given with the official work plan, in March 2009.

Additional payments:

No judge on delegation: 180 Euro

Entries after 19th January 2009: + 20% (accommodation)

If you book outside the accommodations of the OC:

Accreditation will be: entry fee + 60 Euro/person
